These cabinets are made of Black Walnut, very finely finished. They measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ inches deep, 29 inches high and 25 inches wide. Net weight 72 pounds. The panelled doors are hung on brass plated hinges and are securely fastened by a substantial lock with key.

The tools are placed on grooved shelves or fastened to the sides and doors of these cabinets by specially constructed clips.

The handles on each side of the cabinet are used for lifting or carrying.

The drawer at the base of the cabinet is divided into compartments for holding small tools, nails, screws, etc.

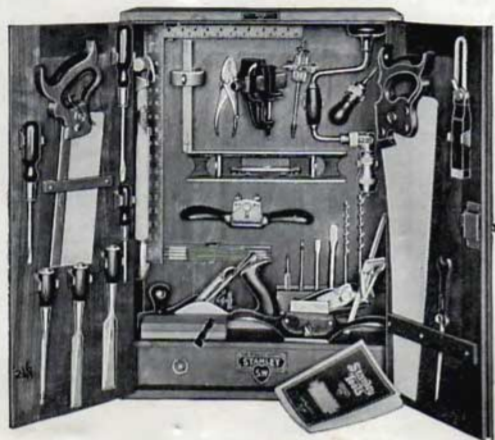

The panelled doors are hung on brass plated hinges, and are securely fastened by a substantial lock with key.

The tools are fastened to the side, back and doors of these cabinets by specially constructed clips which hold them firmly in place.

The handles on each side of the cabinets are used for lifting and carrying.

The drawer is divided into compartments for holding small tools, nails, screws, etc.

Handles are placed at the top of the cabinet for lifting or carrying.

The tools are fastened to the side, back and door of the cabinet by specially constructed clips which hold them firmly in place.

The drawer, in the base of the cabinet, is used for holding small tools, nails, screws, etc.

These boxes are made of Black Walnut, very finely finished. They measure 6 inches deep, 22 inches long and 12 inches high. Net weight 22 pounds. The parts of these boxes that open are hung on brass plated hinges, and are securely fastened by a substantial lock with key.

The tools are held in place by specially constructed clips.

A comfortable leather handle is fastened to the top for carrying.

The drawer at the base of the boxes is used independently of the boxes and is divided into compartments for holding small tools, nails, screws, etc.

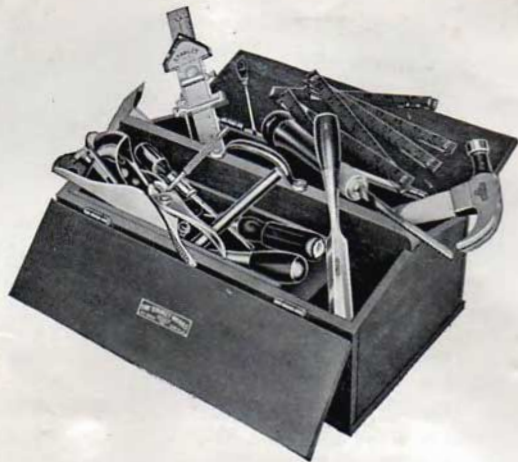

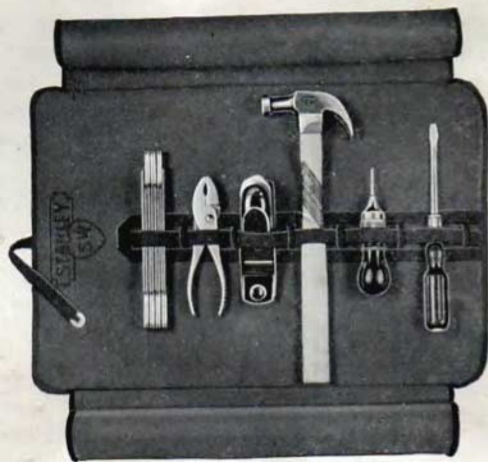
